#### **Privacy Policy**

When you visit our website and more generally use any of our services, we appreciate that you are trusting us with your personal information. We take your privacy very seriously. In this privacy notice, we seek to explain to you in the clearest way possible information we collect, how we use it and what rights you have in relation to it. This privacy notice applies to all information collected through our services, as well as any related services, sales, marketing or events.

#### 1. What information do we collect?

In short: We collect personal information that you provide to us.

#### 2. How do we use your information?

In Short: We process your information for purposes based on business interests, the fulfilment of your order, compliance with our legal obligations, with us and/or your consent.

We use personal information collected by via our website for a variety of business purposes described below. **Vital Interests:** We may disclose your information where we believe it is necessary to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding potential violations of our policies, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the safety of any person and illegal activities, or as evidence in litigation in which we are involved.

#### 4. How Long do we keep your information?

In short: We keep your information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this privacy notice unless otherwise required by law.

When we have no ongoing legitimate business need to process your personal information, we will either delete or anonymize such information, or if this is not possible then we will securely store your information and isolate it from any further processing.

#### 5. How do we keep your information safe?

In short: We aim to protect your personal information through a system of organizational and technical security measures.

We have implemented appropriate technical and organisational security measures designed to protect security of any personal information we process. However, despite our safeguards and efforts to secure information, no electronic transmission over the Internet or information storage technology can be guaranteed to be 100% secure, so we cannot promise or guarantee that hackers, cybercriminals, or other unauthorised third parties will not be able to defeat our security, and improperly collect, access, steal or modify your information.
